At Little Star Foundation it is very common for a mom to share how a mom's intuition, tenacity and love help her child and family.

Andrea asking Austin's Mom: "How did you first learn of your child's cancer?"

"Austin was sick for 5 weeks. We had 7 appointments with 5 different doctors. We were told he had allergies. I knew he didn't have allergies and I spent a lot of time looking up things to have the doctors look into... Lyme disease, blocked salivary glands, etc. We told the doctors he felt like he couldn't breathe and one suggested buying a dehumidifier. It was an extremely difficult and frustrating time. He had so many concerning symptoms.

Finally, we saw a doctor that we had seen 3 weeks prior and the doctor saw that Austin looked worse and ordered imaging tests. We got the results. Austin had a large mass in his chest and it was affecting his breathing. Once we got the results it felt like the entire world collapsed, but it was also a relief to finally have answers so we could start to fight it."

**Andrea:** "What has been the hardest part since your child's diagnosis?"

Austin's Mom: "There has been nothing easy in the past 14 months, but the worst parts have been the constant fear. I'm constantly checking his temperature and asking him how he feels. Also, knowing that he has a tremendous amount of feelings that he keeps to himself. Austin has been hospitalized multiple times. It's a feeling of constant worry as well as not being able to do enough."

**Andrea:** "Do you have a prayer, saying or quote that has helped you?"

Austin's Mom: "I always tell Austin 'even the worst day is one step closer to the end of this! It'll get better and one day this will all be a memory.' It has been awful. Just awful. No doctor would take us seriously for the first 5 weeks Austin was sick. Those and other nights I just cried. I work at a mental health agency night shift and missing work is part of it. I am a single mom now. I was married when Austin was diagnosed. The entire family gets impacted and tough decisions are made during very stressful awful times."

**Andrea:** "What Words of Wisdom would you give to any parent going through what you are?"

**Austin's Mom:** "To not feel guilty. Do not think of all the things you could/should/would have done differently. We all do the best we can. To be positive and as strong as you can. Cry and vent whenever you need to. And just love and comfort however, your child needs/wants you to."

Andrea: "If qualified to receive financial assistance from Little Star Foundation what would the funds be used for?" Austin's Mom: "Rent and/or my electric bill. I'm so used to being self sufficient. I have missed a lot of work due to Austin's different hospitalizations and I need help with bills."

**Andrea:** "What special saying, prayer or Words of Wisdom does Austin share that are encouraging and helpful for your family and others?"

**Austin's Mom:** "Austin has a saying that puts everything into perspective. When I had a flat tire, a cold or something minor, Austin always replies, 'at least it's not cancer'. It really makes minor problems seem even more silly."
